

Art & Sensory Play

More ideas to engage learners in sensory play; Shaving foam marbling pictures

The things you will need; A tray or large shallow bowl. Shaving foam, Food colour or watered down paint. Droppers or teaspoons to drip colours onto the foam. Small pieces of paper or card; Approx 20 x 14 cm or small enough to fit in you tray. A piece of stiff card to scrape the foam from the paper.



First spray a layer of shaving foam to cover the bottom of the tray or bowl. Next use a dropper or teaspoon to drip colours onto the foam.



When you have added your choice of colours, use a chop stick or end of a brush to swirl the colours around.



Press your piece of paper or card onto the shave foam and lift it off. Your paper will lift some of the foam off.



Scrape the foam off the paper with a piece of stiff card to reveal your amazing marbled picture! (Have another bowl beside you to scrape the excess foam into)

3 or 4 pictures can be made from a layer of foam, each time adding more colour and swirl around again. After that, wash it away and replace with fresh shave foam. When your marbled pictures are dry they can be cut into shapes and used to make cards or collages...a great way to get crafty!
